Documentation Guidelines for Mental Health Disorders

Under the Americans in Disabilities Act Amendments Act (ADAAA) and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, individuals with disabilities are protected for imministration and may be entitled to reasonable accommodations and rights optial access to programs and services. A diagnosis of a disorder/condition alone does not automatically qualify an individual for accommodations under the ADAAA. To establish almaindividual is covered under law, the documentation must explain hour disability substantially limits one or more major life activities and supports the request for services, accommodations, academistratejints, and/or auxiliary aids.
